


Singapore's Utilities Sector 2022

Singapore's Utilities Sector¹ provides goods and services such as electricity, gas, water, sewerage and waste collection, which are essential for households and businesses. Data on the utilities sector provide information on the performance of the sector that could be used for policymaking and business decisions.

In 2022, there were about 770 establishments in the Singapore's Utilities Sector, registering a total operating revenue of \$48.5 billion.

After a decline of 11% in 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic, operating revenue rebounded 27% in 2021 and continued to grow 33% in 2022 amidst strong economic growth. Operating expenditure also rose in 2022, recording a 30% increase over 2021.
