Indicator 3.2.1

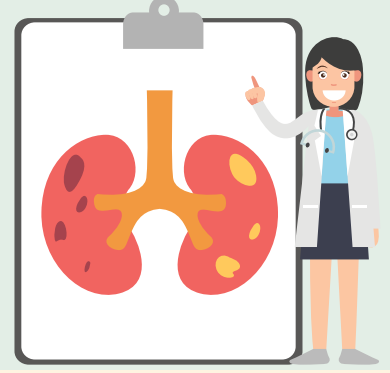
Under-5 Mortality Rate* decreased from 2.6 per 1,000 live births in 2018 to 2.5 per 1,000 live births in 2019

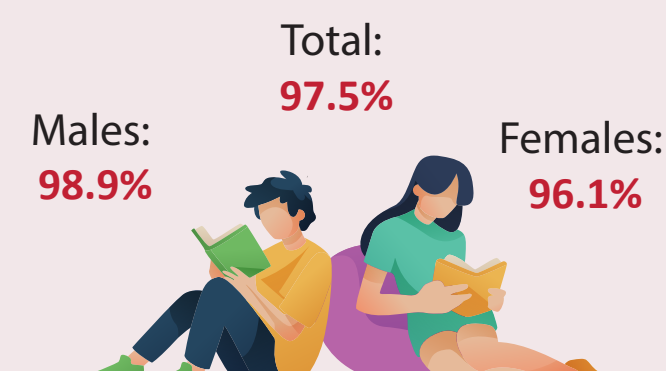
Gross Enrolment Ratio, Gender Parity Index in 2018

Although Singapore does not track data for this indicator, almost **100%** of Singapore's population has access to electricity.



Indicator 7.B.1

Installed Renewable Energy (Solar Photovoltaic) Generating Capacity increased from **23.5 Wac Per Capita in June 2018** to **35.8 Wac Per Capita in June 2019**



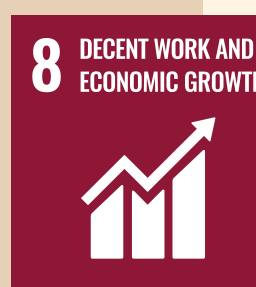
Indicator 14.5.1

Although Singapore does not have legally protected marine areas, extensive research was conducted to enhance marine habitats and enrich biodiversity in Singapore's coastal and marine areas.



Indicator 14.A.1

About **0.2%** of the public research budget for 2016-2020 was allocated to research in the field of marine technology, i.e., to the Marine Science Research & Development Programme (**\$525 mil**) and the St John's Island National Marine Laboratory (**\$518 mil**).



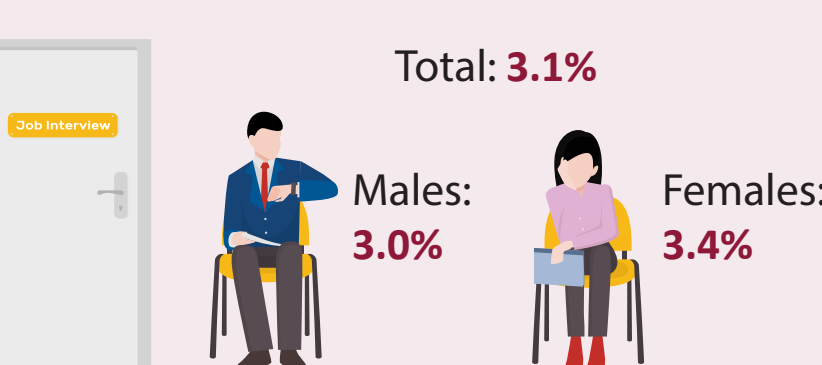

Note: Annual figures are the simple averages of the unemployment figures obtained at quarterly intervals.



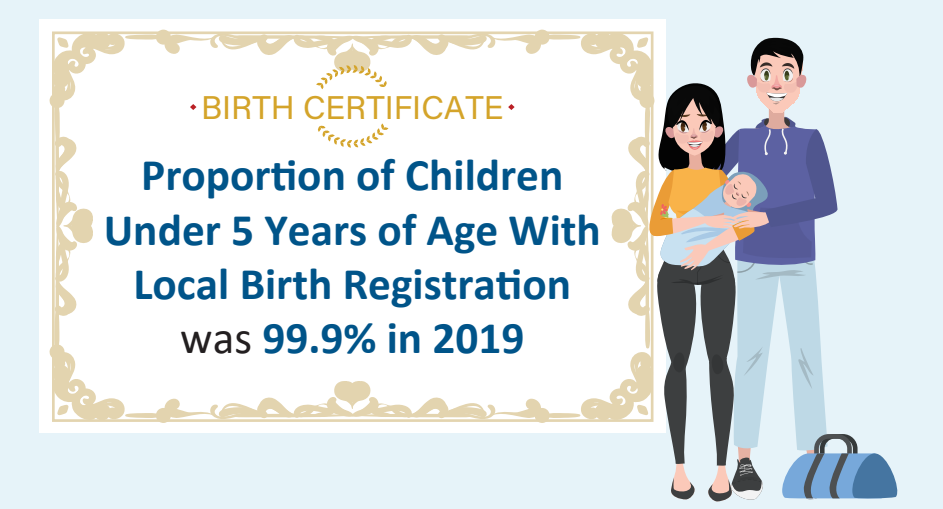
Indicator 16.6.1

Although Singapore does not track this indicator, over **131,000** officials from more than **170** countries and territories have participated in capacity-building programmes under the Singapore Cooperation Programme since 1992, aimed at helping countries achieve the SDGs. Approximately **62%** of participants are from ASEAN.
