

Singapore's Utilities Sector 2023

Singapore's Utilities Sector¹ provides goods and services such as electricity, gas, water, sewerage and waste collection, which are essential for households and businesses. Data on the utilities sector provide information on the performance of the sector that could be used for policymaking and business decisions.

There were about 845 establishments in the Singapore's Utilities Sector in 2023, registering a total operating revenue of \$50.7 billion.

In 2023, operating revenue grew 4.7% while operating expenditure contracted by 1.6%, due primarily to a lower cost of sales in the Electricity, Gas, Steam and Air-conditioning Supply segment.
