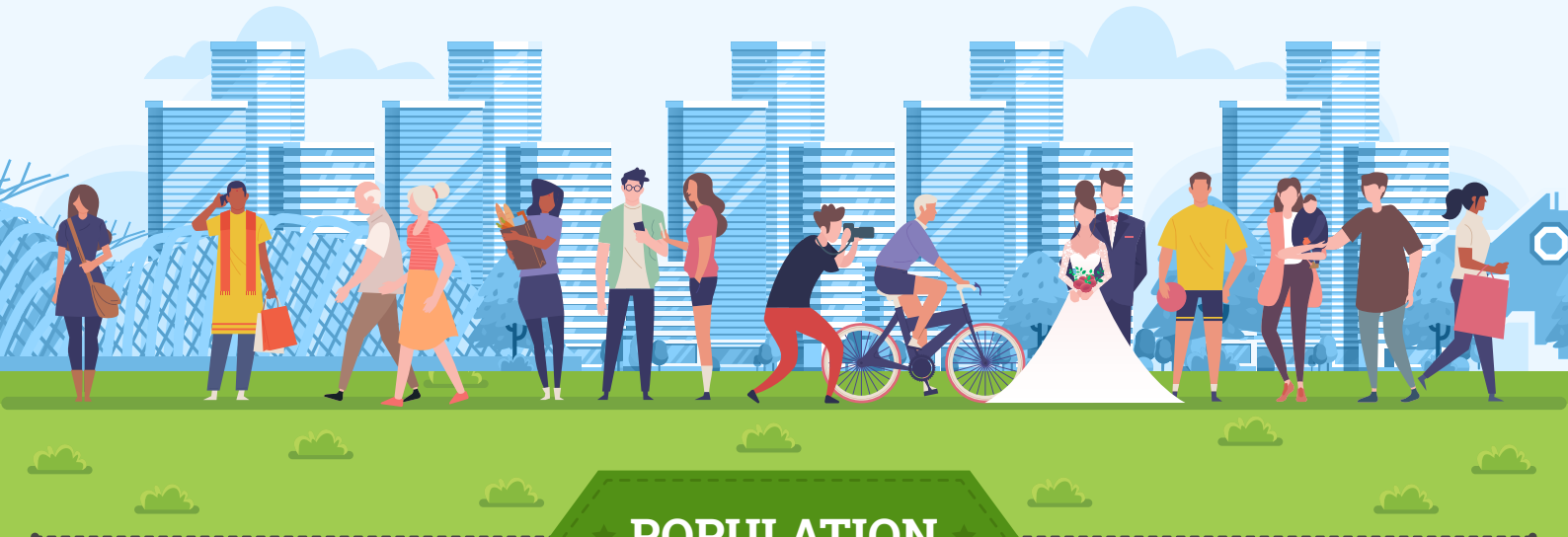

**OLD-AGE SUPPORT RATIO**

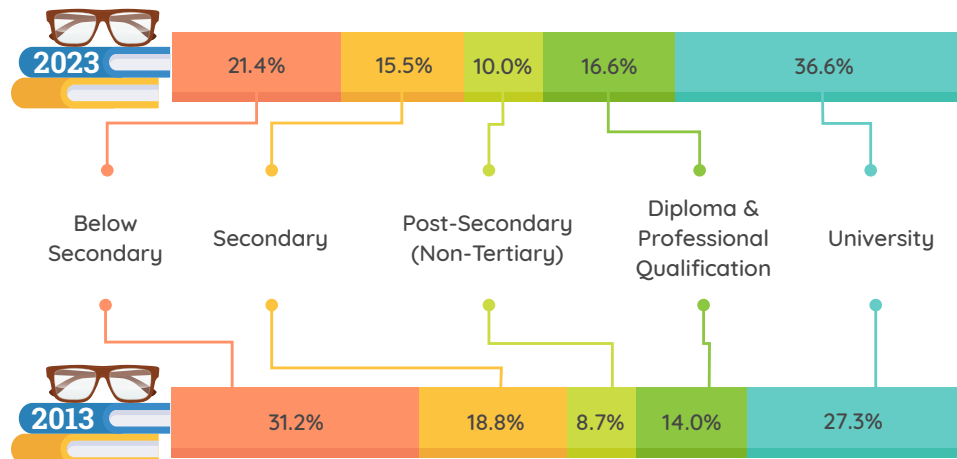

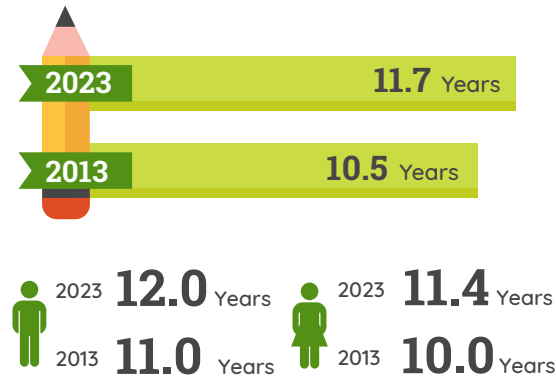
### HIGHEST QUALIFICATION ATTAINED

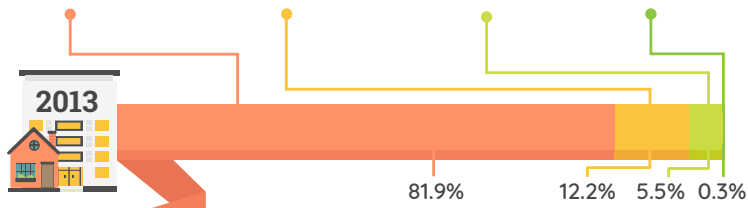
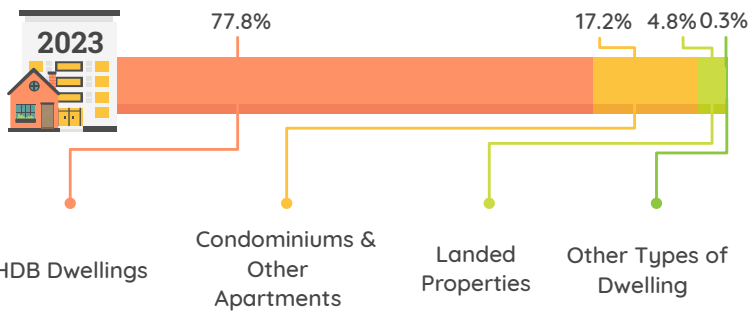

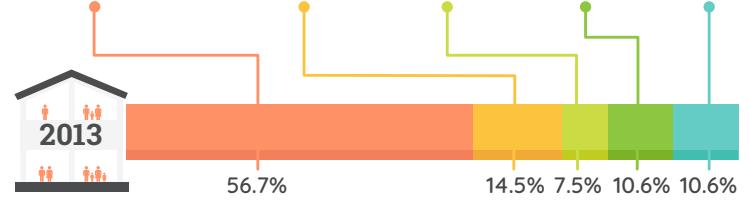
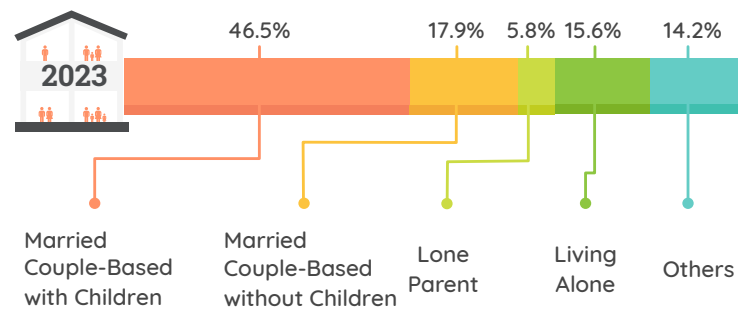

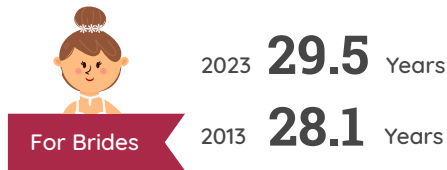
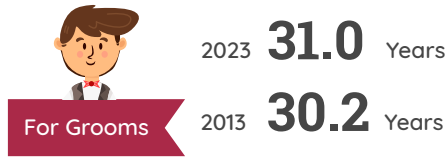

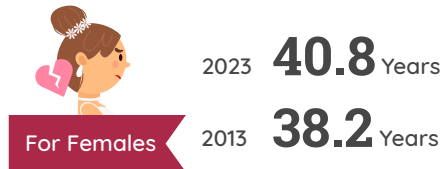
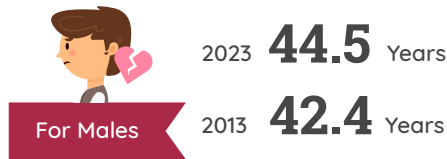

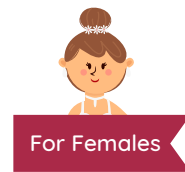
## MEDIAN AGE at FIRST MARRIAGE



## MEDIAN AGE at DIVORCE

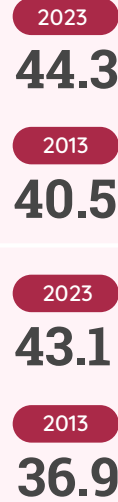


## MEDIAN DURATION of MARRIAGES THAT ENDED IN DIVORCE

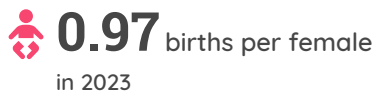

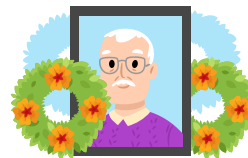

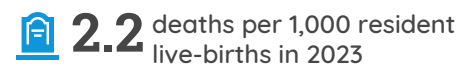


### RESIDENT TOTAL FERTILITY RATE

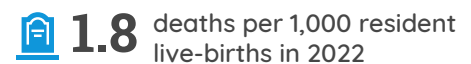

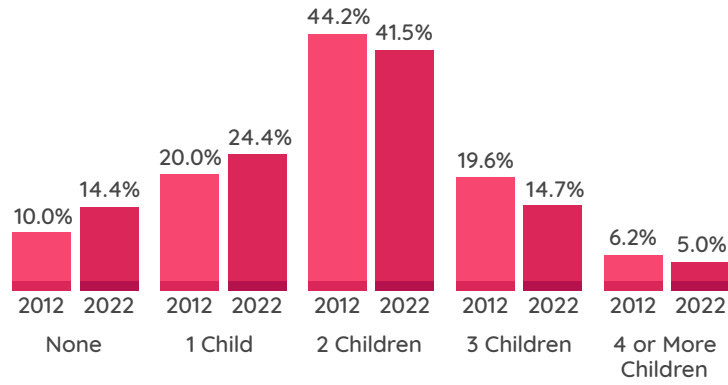
### TOTAL DEATHS in 2023



### INFANT MORTALITY RATE



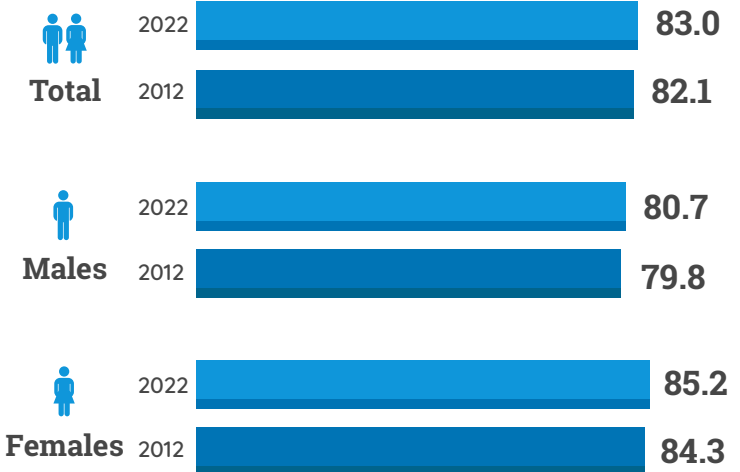
## RESIDENT EVER-MARRIED FEMALES AGED 40-49 YEARS by NUMBER of CHILDREN BORN

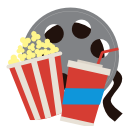
